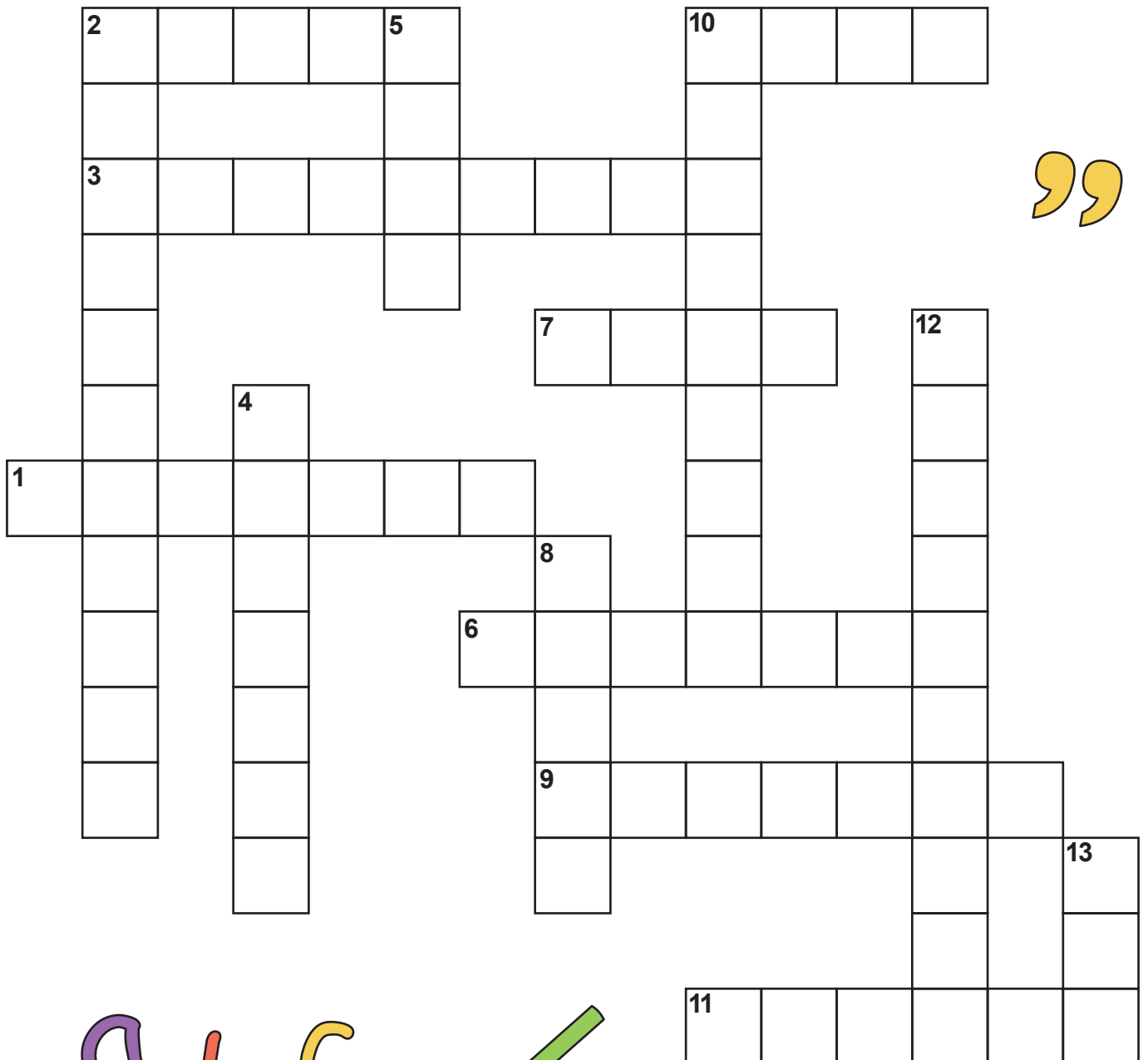

Some answers go across and some go down.



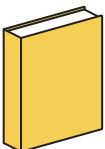
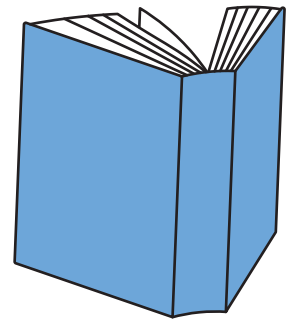
