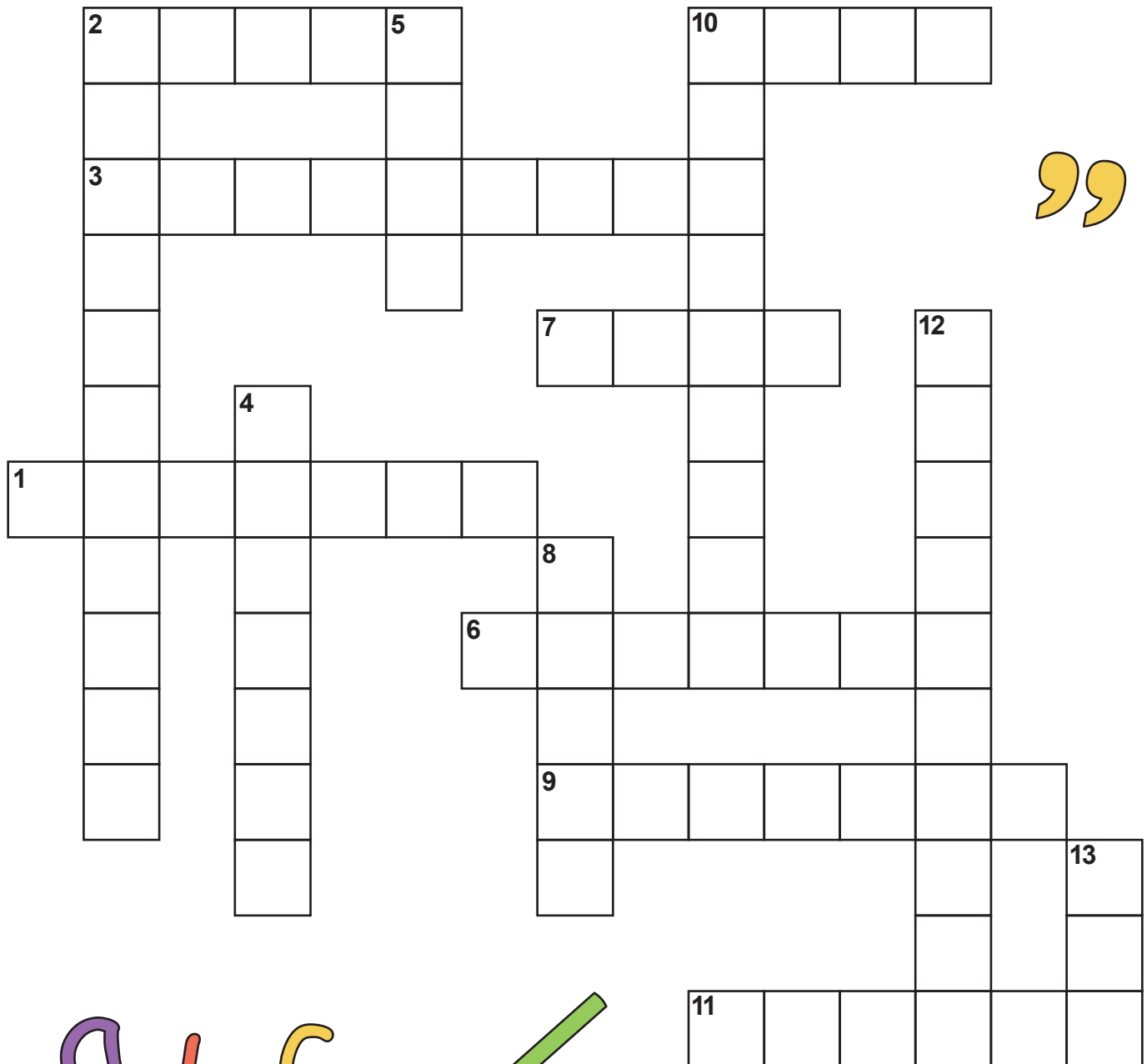
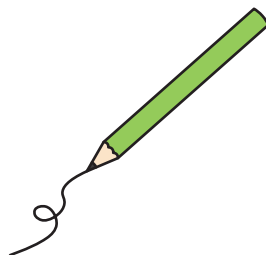


Crossword

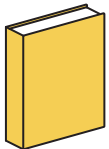
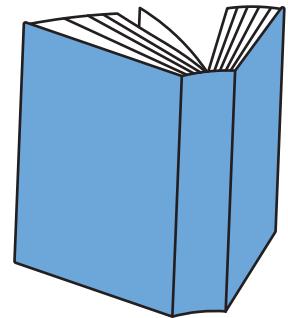
Crossword Clues

- 11 Examples of this type of word are 'quickly', 'happily' and 'very'.

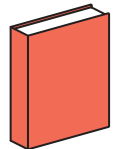

- 13 The point of a pen, out of which the ink flows.



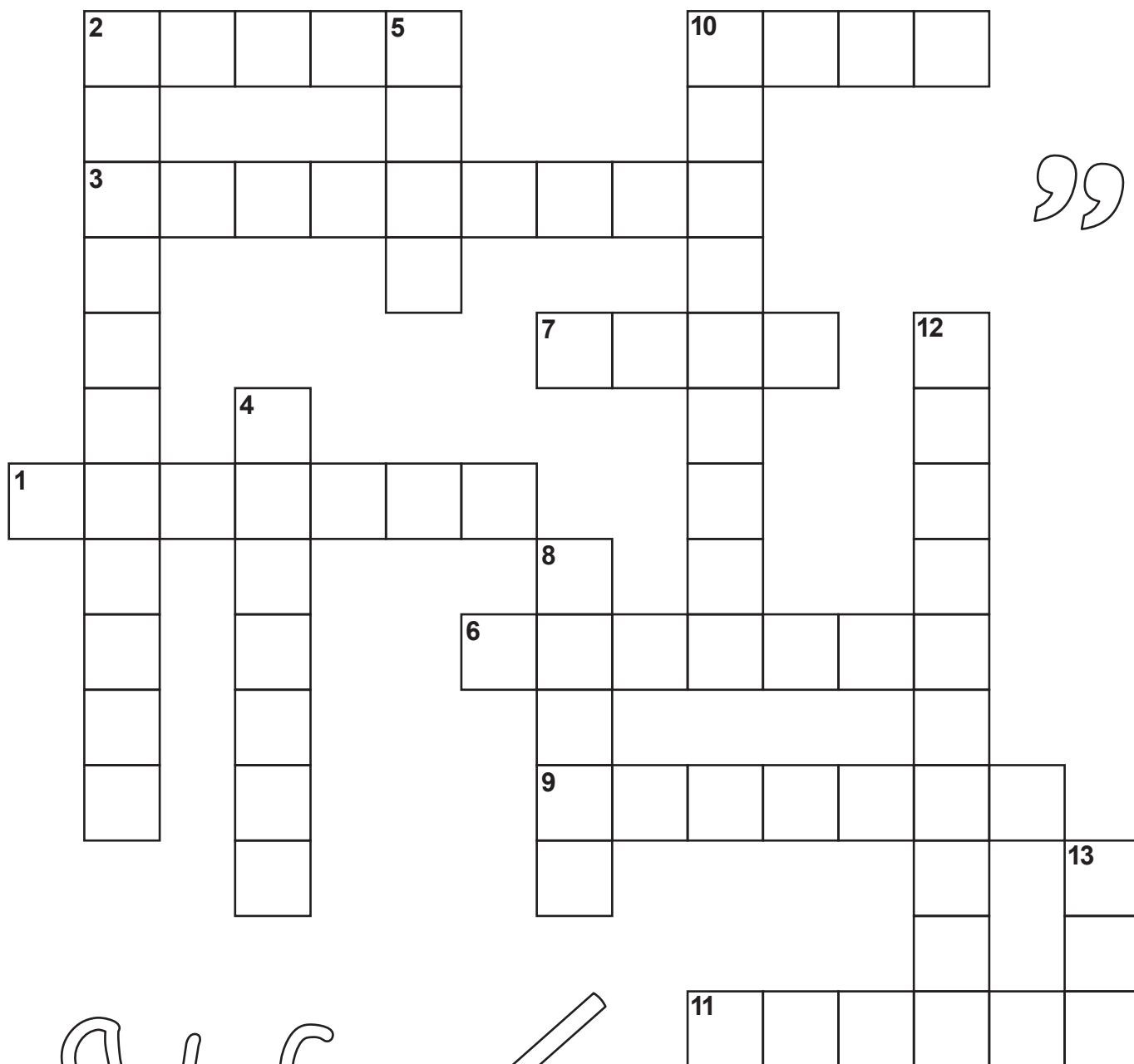
DID YOU KNOW?

The pen gets its name from the Latin word *penna*, meaning "feather" because feather quills were often used historically for writing.

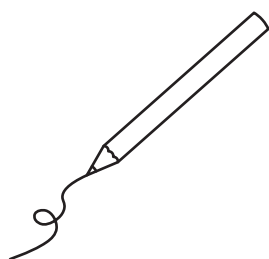


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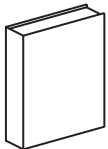
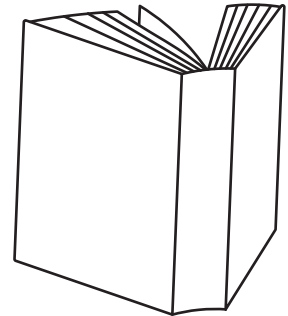
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
